Our Process

- Schedule a 15-20-minute conversation with the leadership at the school to explain our concepts and the information we share with families. It is during this dialogue that we ensure our message is in alignment with the values of the school and, if necessary, how to adjust accordingly.
- Most schools increase attendance at the events by utilizing email marketing or allowing us to promote our event with a table at events already scheduled at the school (i.e. Open House, Parent's Night, College Night).
- 3. Secure a date and location for the event.
- 4. We will provide email invitations that can be sent out.
- 5. We handle all RSVP's.
- 6. Comment sheets are passed out at the even to all attendees. We provide a copy of all comment sheets received at the event to your leadership.
- No parents are contacted for follow up after an event unless they specifically request to do so on the comment sheets.
